

Financial support to attend ECNS-2007 - Bursaries

1 Bursaries

Limited funds are available to provide partial support for attendance at the 4th European Conference on Neutron Scattering (ECNS-2007). The organisers have received sponsorship via the EU supported NMI3 programme:

to support young scientists from the European Union and associated states. Additional sponsorship may allow limited support for some delegates from other countries.

Bursaries will be awarded to young scientists seeking active participation in the Conference who have submitted an abstract for presentation. Applicants will normally receive only partial support such as remission of fees or payment of accommodation in Lund and should indicate in their application other sources of funding. Applications for bursaries should be sent to Professor Adrian Rennie (Adrian.Rennie@fysik.uu.se) and they will continue to be considered while funds are available. Further sponsorship has been received and the original deadline is prolonged until 28 February. The application should not exceed 1 A4 page but must include:

- Full Name and Work Address
- E-mail and complete contact details
- Nationality, gender, date of birth and academic qualifications, number of years of research since Ph.D. or information about status of studies.
- Title of abstract(s) submitted to ECNS-2007 with names of co-authors
- Expected costs for participation in ECNS-2007 and short information about all sources of financial support (applied and agreed).

The application should be sent as an attachment to an e-mail in either PDF format or as a file compatible with MS Word. Bursaries will be allocated according to the rules imposed by the various sponsoring bodies.

2. Other Support

There are other opportunities to gain some financial support for attendance at ECNS:

- (a) The NMI3 Access programme will hold a user meeting during ECNS-2007. Users of these neutron facilities (http://neutron.neutron-eu.net/n_nmi3/n_access_activities) under the NMI3 Access programme may be eligible for support and should contact relevant facilities.
